

Learning Module Outline: Abortion

The following is the basics of what you should learn during the Euthanasia subsection:

1. The major moral principle(s) employed by each author in determining the moral status of abortion.
2. The normative theory employed by each author in determining the moral status of abortion.
3. Those properties that bestow intrinsic value according to each author. What is the consequence of applying that criterion consistently?
4. The moral status of abortion according to each other, and the premises and concepts supporting that conclusion.
5. The two kinds of “life” and which is morally relevant according to each author. When does the morally relevant “life” begin?
6. The difference between direct and indirect rights.
7. Does the moral status change during fetal development?
