Essay Question:

Analyze the following case drawing upon Kant, Garry, and Brison. Formulate an argument discussing the morality of this example:

"In this episode of College Invasion, 3 REAL frat boys get the chance to fuck their favorite porn stars for winning at the weird, but fun, games our pornstars [sic] had them play. First the guys string strawberries onto their cocks and had to swing them into the girls' mouths, then they had to guess what the girls put on their dicks while they were blindfolded.
